Daniel Waigl is the Executive Director of the Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe (CIRSE). He started his career at the European Congress of Radiology, serving in different positions which included Head of Marketing and Communications, before he left in 2004 to join CIRSE. Founded in 1985, CIRSE is a non-profit, educational and scientific association aiming to improve patient care through the support of teaching, science, research and clinical practice in the field of interventional radiology. Today CIRSE counts over 8,000 individual academic members and over 40 National Group Member societies.
